- Images should be manipulated on your PC using a product like Photoshop or Paintshop Pro.
- Transfer images onto the web server abri.une.edu.au via ftp. Your user identifier is <socident>_images. You will be informed what your password is.
- Try to keep the small animal image to as small as possible to speed download times.

Note:

If an animals ident has a space in it then the this space should be replaced by a ^ in the image file name. Eg: Animal Ident: ABC 12345 Image Filename: ABC^12345.gif

If an animals ident has a / in it then the this / should be replaced by a \$ in the image file name. Eg: Animal Ident: ABC/12345 Image Filename: ABC\$12345.gif
